TERMS

The plaque will recognise your financial support and special relationship with Thebby and will remain in place for ten consecutive years. This does not grant the right to sit in that seat during performances, except at special events arranged by Thebarton Theatre.

If the seat is replaced during this time, Thebarton Theatre will move the plaque to another seat. Donors will be notified of the new seat location.

Naming a seat does not entitle the donor to admission to performances, preferred seating allocation, or ownership of the seat. Plaques are a recognition of your contribution and special connection with Thebby.

At the end of the ten-year period, Thebarton Theatre will offer you the first opportunity to continue your association by renaming the seat.

Donations made towards naming a seat are non-refundable.
